<p>Key learning outcomes:</p>	<p>Learners will be offered the opportunity to achieve units of the C&G Personal and Social Development qualification at entry levels 2 and 3 and also level 1.</p> <p>There will be the opportunity to work on the functional skills at entry 3 and level 1 for Maths and English.</p> <p>Day sessions such as drug awareness, alcohol awareness, manual handling and financial inclusion training may also be built into the programme.</p> <p>Learners will be given the opportunity to work towards the Ascentis Preparation for Employment in the Construction Industries at both entry levels and level 1.</p> <p>Learners will receive on how they are progressing with regards to attendance, time keeping, attitude, behaviour and areas for development. Internal certificates will be awarded for various aspects of the programme.</p>
