Curriculum enrichment E.g. additional advice and guidance, reorientation activities.	Information Advice & Guidance would be arranged for any learner with a relevant PA, partner organisation or specialist support agency(s) etc. in order to help with their decision making and give them a clear direction. This would be for all learners on tier 3 who may need some extra 1:1 support, or it may involve current apprentices, who may have become disillusioned with their training/company and need to re-enter E2E to receive some additional support and guidance to help them re-engage with their training.		
Work Placement taster opportunities:	During the 3–6 week period, learners who are still a little undecided or would like a ‘settling-in period’ with their companies, would be given the same opportunities as in tier 2, to sample various occupational areas, or 2/3 companies in a similar area.
